Day 01 – ARRIVAL AT LONDON

Arrival in London –the capital of England and the United Kingdom. In the evening, enjoy the Gala dinner on private cruise on River Thames.

Day 02 – LONDON CITY TOUR

Enjoy London with an English-speaking guide, the tour includes Changing of the Guards at Buckingham palace (subject to operation), photo stop at Trafalgar Square (photo-stop) and outside views of Westminster Abbey, House of Parliament and the Big Ben. Visit Tower of London, a historic castle located on the north bank of the River Thames in The City of London. Later enjoy London Eye ride.

Day 03 – LONDON – WINDSOR – LONDON

LONDON – WINDSOR: 23 miles (36km) from central London. Approx. 1 hour each way by coach depending on traffic

Visit Windsor Castle, a royal residence at Windsor in the English county of Berkshire. It is notable for its long association with the English and later British royal family and for its architecture. Enjoy guided tour of Lord's cricket ground (subject to availability) widely referred to as the Home of Cricket and home to the world's oldest sporting museum, the MCC Museum, which is the oldest sports museum in the world and contains the world's most celebrated collection of cricket memorabilia, including The Ashes urn. MCC has been collecting memorabilia since 1864.

Overnight accommodation in London.

Day 04 – LONDON – OXFORD – BICESTER – LONDON

LONDON – OXFORD: 56 miles (90km) from central London. Approx. 1 hour 45 min by coach depending on traffic

OXFORD – BICESTER: 15 miles (23km). Approx. 35 min by coach depending on traffic

BICESTER – LONDON: 62 miles (100km). Approx. 1 hour 55 min by coach depending on traffic

Visit Oxford with an English speaking guide, a city in central southern England, revolves around its prestigious university, established in the 12th century. The architecture of its 38 colleges in the city's medieval center led poet Matthew Arnold to nickname it the 'City of Dreaming Spires'. Drive to Bicester Village, an outlet shopping center on the outskirts of Bicester, a town in Oxfordshire, home to more than 160 boutiques from the world's leading designers. Return to London in the evening.

Day 05 – LONDON – EDINBURGH

LONDON – EDINBURGH: 402 miles (648km). The average train time is 4 hours 30 minutes.

Today, proceed to Edinburgh. Enjoy the scenic train journey from London to Edinburgh. Arrive in Edinburgh – Scotland's compact, hilly capital.

Overnight accommodation in Edinburgh.

Day 06 – EDINBURGH

Enjoy guided city tour of Edinburgh which includes outside views of Holyrood Palace, Scottish Parliament and St Giles Cathedral along with some free time at Royal Mile and Edinburgh City Centre. Visit Edinburgh Castle, a historic fortress which dominates the skyline of Edinburgh, the capital city of Scotland, from its position on the Castle Rock. Later enjoy Scotch Whiskey Experience – a guided tour plus a nosing and tasting of a Scotch whisky in The World's Largest Collection of Scotch Whisky.

Overnight accommodation in Edinburgh.

Day 07 – EDINBURGH – LOCH LOMOND – GLASGOW – EDINBURGH

EDINBURGH – LOCH LOMOND PIER: 86 miles (139km). Approx. 2 hour drive by coach depending on traffic

LOCH LOMOND PIER - GLASGOW: 42 miles (67km). Approx. 1 hour drive by coach depending on traffic

GLASGOW - EDINBURGH: 47 miles (76km). Approx. 1 hour 10 min drive by coach depending on traffic

Today proceed for Loch Lomond. Enjoy the breath-taking scenic beauty of Loch Lomond while on a cruise. It's part of the Loch Lomond and The Trossachs National Park. The surrounding highlands area is home to red deer and oak woodlands. Arrive at Glasgow and visit Glasgow Transport Riverside Museum - Glasgow's award-winning transport museum. With over 3,000 objects on display there's everything from skateboards to locomotives, paintings to prams and cars to a Stormtrooper. Later enjoy guided city tour of Glasgow including City Chambers, Strathclyde University, Merchant City George Square, SEC Exhibition Centre & Glasgow University. After the tour return to Edinburgh.
