FILMING LOCATION AND ANTRIM COAST

Full day guided tour

Your tour will begin from your pickup location, where you will meet your driver and guide for the day. There we will begin our journey to the north coast traveling through the rolling farmland of County Antrim. The Antrim Coast Road is widely agreed to be one of the finest stretches of road anywhere in the world. The road hugs the coastline giving incredible seaside views, passing unspoiled beaches, and sheltering under rugged cliffs. You may even see Scotland on a good day!



Carrickfergus Castle (Antrim Coast)

Carrickfergus Castle is one of the best-preserved medieval castles in Northern Ireland. It is over 800 years old and is located less than 10 miles north of Belfast. The castle was previously used as a military fortress against attacks from the French, Scottish, and English, as well as the two world wars. However, in 1928 ownership of the castle was passed from the army to the government. The castle itself was not used as a filming location in Game of Thrones, but the town and the nearby Carrick-A-Rede Rope Bridge (more on that below) was

Magheramorne (GOT see)

Is a quarry that was the location of Castle Black and the 1000 mile Ice Wall (all gone)
The Scene: This is the backdrop to Castle Black and Hardhome, and also where the sets are built.
The Reality: Magheramorne is a small hamlet of about 75 people that's home to an old stone quarry.
The cement plant closed in 1980, and the quarry now acts primarily as the set for Game of Thrones. It's been proposed to turn it into a World Cycling Centre and the All-Ireland Scuba Diving Centre

LARNE (Antrim Coast)

Larne is where the real Vikings were routed out of Ireland 1000 years ago

Glenarm (Antrim Coast)

Handcrafted jewellery at its very best, Steensons Économusée was entrusted by HBO to create much of the iconic jewellery used in Game of Thrones, including Joffrey's Crown.

Carnlough (GOT photostop)

The sleepy harbour of Carnlough, famously known as Braavos in Game of Thrones is nestled on the stunning Antrim coastal road in Northern Ireland. In Season 6, Episode 7 (The Broken Man), part of the fictional City Braavos from Game of Thrones was filmed at Carnlough harbour. Arya Stark comes to Braavos to find Jaqen H'ghar, and learns how to become a faceless assassin. She very nearly meets her end in Braavos, when the Waif surprises her from the shadows and repeatedly stabs her, she has to escape quickly to fight for her life.

Cushendun Caves (GOT photostop)

Is the prototype for Port Merriion where the Prisoner with Patrick McGoogan is set (its in Wales) This is a stunning coastal location with incredibly rugged yet beautiful geological features! What happened in these Cushendun caves took many GOT fans by surprise. These beautiful sea caves helped to create the ominous setting of one of the TV show's most mystical and frightening scenes. Here, with Davos Seaworth watching in horror, Melisandre gives birth to the shadow baby that eventually kills Renly Baratheon.

The Fullerton Arms (lunch stop on your own)

The Fullerton Arms has a Game of Thrones Door and a replica of the Iron Throne

Dunluce Castle (GOT photostop)

The talented filmmakers at HBO transform Dunluce Castle into House Greyjoy, situated in the capital of the Iron Islands. The castle itself has a complicated history, including several infamous owners and ties to the Spanish Armada. The mounted cannons on the exterior walls came from La Girona, the Spanish Armada ship which sunk near the Giant's Causeway. In 2003, for his film The Medallion, Jackie Chan filmed several scenes at the castle. The medieval castle has drawn international attention from artists and locations scouts alike - its characteristic rocky cliffs make it the perfect site for House Greyjoy and the cloudy Iron Islands.

Downhill Castle (Dragonstone) (GOT photostop)

The seven-mile (11.3-kilometre) coast of Downhill Strand is the location set for Stannis Baratheon and his enchanting mistress, Melisandre, throughout the earlier seasons of the show. Sitting atop the rocky cliffs, Mussenden Temple may look out of place architecturally as it was originally modelled on a Roman Temple in 1785. The Strand is also the home of Dragonstone Temple, belonging to House Baratheon in season one, which is computer generated in its entirety and makes use of the backdrop on this Northern coast. Further scenes for the Stannis' plot line were filmed across different points of the coast, including the caves of Cushendun, where Melisandre gave birth to the shadow demon.

The Dark Hedges (GOT photostop)

The Dark Hedges is one of the most photographed areas in Northern Ireland and a popular attraction for tourists from across the world. This beautiful avenue of beech trees was planted by the Stuart family in the 18th century and intended to impress visitors as they approached the entrance to Gracehill House.

The site featured in Game of Thrones series two, doubling as the Kingsroad which young Arya Stark travelled on in the back of a cart along with Yoren, Gendry and Hot Pie - all new recruits for the Night's Watch.



TITANIC BELFAST

A WORLD LEADING VISITOR ATTRACTION

Located beside the Titanic Slipways, the Harland & Wolff Drawing Offices and Hamilton Graving Dock – the very place where Titanic was designed, built and launched, Titanic Belfast tells the story of Titanic from her conception, through her construction and launch, to her maiden voyage and subsequent place in history.
